



Corona virus: Information on vaccination in the Canton of Zurich

As of April 9, 2021

Vaccination is voluntary and free.

Can I be vaccinated?

You can be vaccinated if

- > you are over 16 years of age
 - > you don't have a fever or any other COVID 19 symptoms
 - > you don't have an allergy against one of the components of the vaccine (PEG)
 - > you are not in isolation or quarantine
- > Pregnant women, breastfeeding mothers, allergy sufferers with a severe reaction in the past and people with severe immune suppression must consult their doctor before being vaccinated.

Can I register for vaccination now?

All persons aged 16 and over who are willing to be vaccinated can register for the Covid 19 vaccination. People aged 65 and over and people with chronic illnesses can currently book a vaccination appointment. If you suffer from a chronic disease, please contact your doctor. For vaccination in a vaccination centre, you need a medical certificate.
